

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Commerce Committee Contract with Daniel S. Press)

RES. NO. 64-87

1 WHEREAS, Rosemary Lopez, Chairperson of the Commerce Committee did receive a
2 contract proposed by Daniel S. Press representing the firm of Heron,
3 Burchette, Ruckert & Rothwell; and

4 WHEREAS, the contract provides the mechanism for developing a comprehensive
5 approach to economic development, for obtaining new authority for the
6 health department, for assisting farms to be created pursuant to the
7 water settlement to participate in USDA crop support programs, and for
8 assisting the Committees of this Council to prepare their juris-
9 dictional statements; and

11 WHEREAS, Daniel S. Press has in the past provided services to the Nation in the
12 area of TERO and Health; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does see a need to utilize the
14 services proposed in this contract; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council, by Resolution 13-87 instructed
16 its Commerce Committee to renegotiate said contract to address
17 concerns of the Council, and said negotiations have been successfully
18 completed such that a satisfactory revised proposal and contract have
19 been submitted by Daniel S. Press; and

21 WHEREAS, aforementioned Resolution 13-87 also instructed the Budget & Finance
22 Committee of this Council to identify funds to pay the costs for the
23 services of Mr. Press, and that Committee has informed the Council
24 that it has identified the necessary funds.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
26 hereby approves the contract submitted by Daniel S. Press to:

- 27 1. Assist the Nation develop a comprehensive approach
28 to economic development.
- 29 2. Obtain legislation permitting the irrigated farms
30 to be created out of the water case settlement to
31 participate in USDA farm support programs from the
32 farm's inception.
3. Assist the Nation obtain legislation designating

1 its Health Department as a demonstration project
2 with certain benefits, exemptions and funding.

- 3 4. Assist the Committees of the Legislative Council
4 to prepare their jurisdictional statements.

5 The contract is, by reference, made a part of this Resolution.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council authorizes
7 and appropriates a sum not to exceed \$38,000 [\$32,500 for the
8 Commerce Committee] and [\$5,500 for all Legislative Committees],
9 to pay for the services to be provided under the contract by Mr.
10 Press, said funds coming from such accounts as designated by the
11 Budget & Finance Committee, namely: Administrative Provisions.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$25,000 shall be paid to Mr. Dan Press out of the
13 Water Resources budget.


14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$3,000 shall be paid to Mr. Dan Press out of the
15 Health Board's budget.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairmen of the various Council Committees
17 listed in the contract as the Nation's contract representatives shall
18 serve in those capacities and shall report regularly to the Council
19 on the work products being provided through the contract.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cost of all services combined shall not exceed
21 \$66,000.

23 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th
24 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
25 of 1262.0 for; 199.5 against; 178.5 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the
26 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-
27 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
28 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
29 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
30 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
