4 Improvement Act, which has been introduced in the U.S. Senate; and


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8 WHEREAS, the following position statement concerning Senate Bill 129 has been

11 O'Odham Nation does adopt the position statement.


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the position statement of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
13 be forwarded to the Chairman of the Senate Select Committee on Indian
14 Affairs and the House Interior and Insular Affairs Committee as well
15 as appropriate congressional and agency offices of the government.
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18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th
19 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
20 of 1581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the
21 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitu-
22 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
