

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support of Demonstration Project to allow the Tohono O'Odham
Community Health Department to further its Organizational Development)

RES. NO. 66-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Community Health Department (TOCHD) has established
2 a set of long range strategic goals for the organizational develop-
3 ment of the Tohono O'Odham Community Health Department which are:
4

- 5 1. Develop an O'Odham-operated Community Health Department
6 based on the health promotion-disease prevention model.
- 7 2. Develop O'Odham human resources in the health
8 professional skill positions necessary to operate a
9 Community Health Department and to manage a comprehensive
10 health care service delivery system.
- 11 3. Develop a Health Department based administrative and
12 management operational structure which would support
13 comprehensive tribal contracting of the entire
14 reservation-based health care service delivery system.
- 15 4. Develop alternative sources of funding Health Department
16 health care delivery to reduce as practical absolute
17 dependency on federal funding sources.
- 18 5. To support the maximization of resources, integrate
19 available public sector resources with private sector
20 resources, establish professional relationship with
21 private-sector health care provider (Affiliation) to
22 ensure mainstreaming of tribal health care service
23 delivery system.

18 WHEREAS, these strategic goals are consistent with the expressed intent of the
19 Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, P.L. 93-638;
20 and

22 WHEREAS, PL 93-638 provides the Tohono O'Odham Nation direct authority and re-
23 sponsibility in determining and responding to the Tribally identified
24 health care needs of the community as well as insuring the organ-
25 izational growth and development of the Tohono O'Odham Community
26 Health Department; and

27 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Community Health Board, consisting of the Health
28 and Human Services Committee of the Legislative Council and the Health
29 Advisory Group (HAG), believes this can be accomplished efficiently
30 and rapidly through a demonstration project which would focus on the
31 development of a comprehensive community health department in con-
32 junction with private sector health care providers; and

WHEREAS, such efforts are consistent with current Federal administrative policy and will demonstrate the efficient use of limited Federal fiscal resources available for health care services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council directs the Tohono O'Odham Health Department to develop the capacity to design, administrate and manage the Nation's comprehensive health care service delivery system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation is requesting a formal demonstration project to accomplish this initiative.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Community Health Department shall seek Congressional support and appropriate funding for this proposed demonstration project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Community Health Department will quarterly brief the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the status of this demonstration project. Should a demonstration be funded at some future date, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council requests quarterly reports through the demonstration project period.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Community Health Department shall be responsible for project oversight and will provide direction throughout the demonstration period.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) and (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
