

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Phoenix Indian High School)

RES. NO. 69-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is concerned about education issues affect-
2 ing Tohono O'odham membership; and
3 WHEREAS, the student cottages at Bihinol Du'ag High School have not been const-
4 ructed which will result in the continued attendance of approximately
5 76 Tohono O'odham students at off-reservation boarding schools; and
6 WHEREAS, although the Tohono O'odham Nation will be opening the doors of a new
7 high school for students in the fall of 1987, there is still a need
8 for alternative facilities and programs for those students who reside
9 too far from reservation secondary schools and for those who are
10 referred for social reasons.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation fully supports
13 the language in the legislative proposal submitted by the Inter Tribal
14 Council of Arizona,... "Assured that the Secretary of Interior will
15 continue operation of the school and properly operate and maintain
16 the facilities of the Phoenix Indian School until such time as
17 Congress expressly approves the closure of the school and until suit-
18 able alternative arrangements have been made to meet the needs of the
19 students served by the school... That in the event Phoenix Indian
20 School is closed: an amount equal to forty-five percent of the fair
21 market be deposited into a trust fund for member tribes of the Inter-
22 Tribal Council of Arizona...."

24 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2nd
25 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
26 1264.0 for; -0- against; 259.0 not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant
27 to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 c 2 & f of Article VI of the
28 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
29 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary
30 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
31 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
