RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Phoenix Indian High School)

RES. NO. 69-87

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is concerned about education issues affecting Tohono O'odham membership; and

WHEREAS, the student cottages at Bihinol Du'ag High School have not been constructed which will result in the continued attendance of approximately 76 Tohono O'odham students at off-reservation boarding schools; and WHEREAS, although the Tohono O'odham Nation will be opening the doors of a new high school for students in the fall of 1987, there is still a need for alternative facilities and programs for those students who reside too far from reservation secondary schools and for those who are referred for social reasons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation fully supports the language in the legislative proposal submitted by the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona,..."Assured that the Secretary of Interior will continue operation of the school and properly operate and maintain the facilities of the Phoenix Indian School until such time as Congress expressly approves the closure of the school and until suitable alternative arrangements have been made to meet the needs of the students served by the school... That in the event Phoenix Indian School is closed: an amount equal to forty-five percent of the fair market be deposited into a trust fund for member tribes of the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona...."

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the $\underline{2nd}$ day of \underline{March} , $\underline{1987}$, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $\underline{1264.0}$ for; $\underline{-0-}$ against; $\underline{259.0}$ not voting; and $\underline{05}$ absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 c 2 & f of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
