


RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Waiver of Bureau Policy Restricting TWEPP Placement)

RES. NO. 72-87


1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through the Tohono O'odham Human Service
2 Department administer a Tribal Work Experience Program; and
3 WHEREAS, Bureau of Indian Affairs policy (66 BIAM 5.9A(1)) prohibits placement
4 of TWEPP participants in commercial, profit making enterprises; and
5 WHEREAS, this policy restricts employment opportunities for participants in
6 the Tribal Work Experience Program and deters potential economic
7 independence; and
8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation would benefit from a waiver of the policy
9 limiting placement opportunities of TWEPP participants.

11 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that
12 it does hereby approve and support the removal of the restrictions
13 placed on TWEPP participants and hereby directs and authorizes to
14 obtain the appropriate policy waivers.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2nd
16 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 1523.0 for; -0- against; 117.0 not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 f of Article VI of the Constitution
19 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
20 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).

either approve or disapprove it within 48 hours of submittal.


