Whereas: The Department of the Interior has proposed to Congress the allocation of funds for the purpose of funding self-assistance programs such as "workfare" for Indian Tribes: and

Whereas: the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the needs for a program which will foster economic independence and self sufficency in individuals and families; and

Whereas: the Tohono O'Odham Human Service Department has primary responsibility over the financial assistance program and the Tribal Work Experience Program; and

Whereas: the Tohono O'Odham Human Service Department proposes to apply for funds to develop and implement a Workfare Demonstration Project which will foster economic independence and self sufficency for general assistance recipients; and

Whereas: the nature of the Workfare Demonstration Project requires a co-ordinated effort between tribal, state and federal agencies; and

Whereas: the Tohono O'Odham Nation is eligible to apply for funds for a Workfare Demonstration Project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve and authorize the Tohono O'Odham Human Service Department to apply for funds for a Workfare Demonstration Project.
