1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is empowered to promote,
2 protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education
3 and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is further empowered to
6 provide for the maintenance of law and order and the administration
7 of justice; to establish law enforcement agencies; and


8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has contracted for Law Enforcement Services
9 under P.L. 93-638, including the Criminal Investigation Function;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department does investigate all major
12 crimes.

14 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
15 supports the Tohono O'odham Police Department in continuing to
16 contract for the Criminal Investigation function under P.L. 93-638.

18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2nd
19 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1282.0 for; -0- against; 117.0 not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the
21 powers vested in the Council by Section 1c 2 & 6 of Article VI of the
22 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
