

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Housing Improvement Program)

RES. NO. 76-87

1 WHEREAS, THE Tohono O'odham Nation is supportive of the Housing Improvement  
2 Program under the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

3 WHEREAS, The eligible members include the Elderly, Handicap and low income; and

4 WHEREAS, current level of funding is inadequate to serve the needs of the  
5 Tohono O'odham Nation; and


6 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is

8 opposed to the 23% cut for FY 88 Housing Improvement Program Budget.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is opposed  
10 to any recessions for FY 87.


11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham does not support the suspension  
12 of new construction as an allowable activity.

13 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2nd  
14 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
15 1523.0 for; -0- against; 117.0 not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the  
16 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
17 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
18 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
19 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
20 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
