3 Fund"; and

4 WHEREAS, said funds would be deposited in a interest earning account; and

5 WHEREAS, interest earned would be utilized to begin the process of establishing
6 a foundation for economic development resources and activities; and


7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is supportive of San Xavier

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
11 hereby approve the withdrawal of \$100,000.00 for the San Xavier
12 District.


13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and/or Comptroller of the Nation
14 shall provide assistance to the Treasurer of the San Xavier District
15 in securing the withdrawal of such funds from the District's IIM
16 Account.

19 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers
21 vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) (2) of Article VI of the Constitution of
22 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
