

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Compensation for Appropriation Committee)

RES. NO. 80-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council received memos dated February 26, 1987 from
2 Angelo Joaquin, Sr., Chairman of the Appropriation Committee. In the
3 memo, he requested in behalf of the Committee to be compensated at the
4 Council pay rate during the Appropriation Hearings in Washington D.C.;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council convened during the same period as the Approp-
7 riation Hearing, therefore, entitles the Appropriation Committee as
8 members of the Legislative Council to be compensated at the Council
9 pay rate; and

10 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council discussed the issue and decided that the
11 Appropriation Committee will be compensated at the rate of \$75.00 set
12 for Committees.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council rejects the Approp-
14 riation's Committee request for Council pay.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council concluded that the Approp-
16 riation Committee will be compensated at the rate of \$75.00 set for
17 Committees.

18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 3rd
19 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1348.5 for; 105.5 against; 186.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the
21 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitu-
22 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
23 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
24 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
25 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
