18		exists substantial issues related to proceedings and/or actions of the
19		Superior Court of the State of California - for the County of

22		Tohono O'Odham Nation, whom has requested total anonymity; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Chairman, the Legislative Council Chairperson, the
24		Children's Court Judge, and most recently the Nation's Budget &
25		Finance Committee are aware of the situation involving baby boy,
26		d.o.b. 09-09-82, and the financial impact an appeal or further
27		proceedings initiated by the Tohono O'Odham Nation, could have on the

30		authorize the continuation of legal proceedings by the Nation's Legal
