

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Pima Community College District Agreement)

RES. NO. 83-87

1 WHEREAS, the various departments of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are at times in  
2 need of educational and consulting services which can be funded in  
3 part through departmental budgets, grants and contracts which have  
4 been approved by this Council, and in part through State Aid Revenue  
5 provisions based on full-time student equivalent criteria and through  
6 paid tuitions; and

8 WHEREAS, the Pima Community College District has in the past provided such ser-  
9 vices and it is to the advantage of this Nation that an ongoing re-  
10 lationship be established with the College pursuant to an Intergovern-  
11 mental Agreement which will permit individual departments of this  
12 Nation, with the approval of the Chairman, to contract for such  
13 services, provided that the Nation's obligations to pay therefore  
14 shall at no time exceed the amount of funds made available to or by  
15 the Nation under the provisions of any departmental budget, grant or  
16 contract previously approved by this Council; and

18 WHEREAS, the Council approves of the attached Intergovernmental Agreement.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it does hereby authorize the Chairman of  
20 the Tohono O'Odham Nation to execute the attached Intergovernmental  
21 Agreement dated as of July 1, 1986, with the Pima Community College  
22 District, and does hereby further authorize the various departments  
23 of this Nation, with the approval of the Chairman, to enter and  
24 execute contracts, and any amendments thereto, for educational and  
25 consulting services pursuant to provisions and subject to the limit-  
26 ations of such Agreement.

28 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 3rd  
29 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
30 1581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers  
31 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the  
32 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
