

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Revote on top six candidates for PTUA)

RES. NO. 84-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council on February 6, 1987 did by Resolution No.  
2 62-87 authorize the appointment for the following: Papago Tribal  
3 Utility Board (PTUA), Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO), and  
4 Farm Board; and

5 WHEREAS, nominations were open for candidates to the PTUA Board; and

6 WHEREAS, fourteen (14) names were nominated by various districts for the PTUA  
7 Board with none receiving a majority of the votes cast.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that another vote be  
10 conducted on the top six (6) candidates for the PTUA Board.

12 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 3rd  
13 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
14 881.5 for; 631.5 against; 127.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the  
15 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
16 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
17 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
18 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
19 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
