

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Revote on candidates for TERO Commission)

RES. NO. 85-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council on February 6, 1987 did by Resolution No.
2 62-87 authorize the appointment for the following: Papago Tribal
3 Utility Board (PTUA), Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO), and
4 Farm Board; and

5 WHEREAS, nominations were open for candidates to the Tribal Employment Rights
6 Office Commission; and

7 WHEREAS, the outcome of the votes cast for candidates to the TERO Commission
8 indicated that one vacancy did not receive the required majority
9 vote.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council conduct another
12 vote for the candidates with less than the required majority vote
13 necessary for appointment to the TERO Commission.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the cut off on the list
15 of names be made with Carmella Ortega.

17 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 3rd
18 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 217.0 for; 1365.0 against; 58.0 not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the
20 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
21 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
22 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
23 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
24 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
