

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Run-off between the two candidates for TERO Commission)

RES. NO. 86-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council received nominations from the various Council
2 Representatives to the TERO Commission; and

3 WHEREAS, one vacancy did not receive the required majority vote necessary for
4 appointment; and

5 WHEREAS, a run-off is necessary to determine who the other member of the TERO
6 Commission would be.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that a run-off be
8 conducted between Raymond Maldonado and Juan Joe Cipriano to determine
9 the vacancy on the TERO Commission.

11 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 3rd
12 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
13 1023.5 for; 558.5 against; 58.0 not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the
14 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
15 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
16 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
18 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
