1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council convened for their General Session on March 4,
2 1987 and because of the article in the newspaper regarding William
3 Farrison, the issue of the Tohono O'Odham Judge was raised; and

5 WHEREAS, previous attempts to address the issues surrounding the appointment of
6 Mr. William Farrison was raised without any results.
7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the issue of the
8 Judge be placed as the first item on the agenda for tomorrow's Council
9 agenda.
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11 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
12 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
13 1534.5 for; 105.5 against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the
14 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
15 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
16 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
18 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


