

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(EPA-SWDA Proposal)

RES. NO. 91-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council by Resolution No. 558-86 did  
2 direct the Water Management Committee, Water Resource Department and  
3 the Health Board to review and make recommendations regarding the EPA-  
4 SWDA, and primacy issue; and

5 WHEREAS, the recommendations to the Legislative Council was to:

- 6 (1) as of April 1, 1987 all non-PTUA systems would  
7 pay for the Water Sample Collection Project.
- 8 (2) that a Public Water Supply Supervision Program  
9 (PWSSP) be established within the Tohono O'Odham  
10 Water Resource Department to schedule and  
11 coordinate community meetings towards all com-  
12 munities not under PTUA; and

12 WHEREAS, the PWSSP will eventually provide administrative framework for primacy  
13 towards the Safe Drinking Water Act; and


14 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approves the  
15 recommendations except for Recommendation #1.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
17 hereby approves of the following:

- 18 (1) that the establishment of the PWSSP be approved with  
19 funding in the amount of \$9,225.00 up to a six (6)  
20 month period.
- 21 (2) that the Health Department will continue the water  
22 sampling and costs incurred will be paid by the  
Tohono O'Odham Nation.

23 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th  
24 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
25 1105.5 for; 406.0 against; 128.5 not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the  
26 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the  
27 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
