

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(San Xavier District Revenue Sharing Budget FY 87)

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Legislative Council did allocate
2 \$13,401.00 of Federal Revenue Sharing funds to each of the (11)
3 eleven Districts; and

4 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District did hold public hearings as required by law;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, upon input from such hearings the San Xavier District Council did
7 adopt the attached budget in the amount of \$13,401.00; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approves the
9 budget.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
12 the \$13,401.00 allocated to the San Xavier District be disbursed in
13 accordance with the attached budget.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
16 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the powers
18 vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
19 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
