

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Judiciary Committee to convene on March 9, 1987)

RES. NO. 95-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council met on March 5, 1987 to address the issue  
2 surrounding the appointment of Mr. Farrison as the Tohono O'Odham  
3 Judge; and

4 WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Judiciary Committee informed the Legislative  
5 Council that a registered voter has filed charges against the Judge  
6 as provided for under Article IX - Section 2 (b) [Removal from  
7 Office]; and

9 WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee will initiate the proceedings under Section  
10 2 (Removal upon Accusation) by scheduling to convene on March 13, 1987  
11 as the hearing date; and

12 WHEREAS, members of the Council deem it necessary and important that the issue  
13 be addressed immediately.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Judiciary Committee will convene on  
15 March 9, 1987 and that the notice be served to Mr. Farrison  
16 regarding the date.

18 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th  
19 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
20 712.0 for; 741.5 against; 186.5 not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the  
21 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
22 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
