

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Health Complex Roof Repair)

RES. NO. 96-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health Complex is a valuable and essential asset of  
2 the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and

3 WHEREAS, leaking roofs in all of the buildings in the Health Complex cause  
4 hardship and threaten this national asset.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Health Director be given the authority  
6 to work with the Tribal Attorney and Tribal Lobbyist to get the roofs  
7 of the Health Complex repaired through legal action or through other  
8 sources of funding.

10 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th  
11 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
12 1581.5 for; 58.5 against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers  
13 vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) and (1) (2) of Article VI of the  
14 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
