

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Requesting Continued Funding Of Initiatives and Activities
under the Omnibus Drug Act of 1986, P.L. 99-570.)

RES. NO. 97-87

1 WHEREAS, the United States Congress passed and President Reagan signed the
2 Omnibus Drug Act of 1986, P.L. 99-570; and

3 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Drug Act authorizes \$33 million dollars in FY 88 to
4 continued financial support for initiatives established under the
5 Act of FY 87; and


6 WHEREAS, the proposed FY 88 Indian Health budget allocates no money for
7 continued support of initiatives established under the Omnibus Drug
8 Act of 1986.

9 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation acknowledges its
10 reponsibility to deal with drug and alcohol issues on the reservation,
11 however, the Nation also acknowledges that continued financial support
12 from the Federal Administration is necessary to ensure the success of
13 the Tohono O'odham Nation.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation requests that funding
15 for substance abuse and other programs initiated or augmented through
16 the Omnibus Drug Act of 1986, P.L. 99-570, be restored to levels
17 necessary to fulfill the objectives of P.L. 99-570 and the needs of
18 the Indian communties.

19 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
20 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers
22 vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
23 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
24 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
25 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
26 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
