

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Tabling Resolution "Approving Intertribal Policy
on Archaeological Artifacts and Remains")

2 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council on January 3, 1989 reviewed the
3 resolution submitted by the Cultural Preservation
4 Committee requesting the Council to adopt a policy
5 statement for the protection of archaeological artifacts
6 and remains; and

7 WHEREAS, the resolution further requests that Danny Preston and
8 Pauline Miguel be designated as members of the Advisory
9 Task Force; and

10 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council in their discussion of the
11 recommendation for the Advisory Task Force agreed that
12 the membership should come from the Cultural
13 Preservation Committee.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
15 Council that the resolution "Approving Intertribal
16 Policy On Archaeological Artifacts and Remains" is
17 hereby tabled and referred back to Cultural Preservation
18 Committee to designate members from its Committee to
19 represent the Tohono O'odham Nation on the Advisory Task
20 Force.

21 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham
22 Council on the 4th. day of January, 1989 at a meeting at which a
23 quorum was present with a vote of 1,189.0 for; -0- against;
24 451.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
25 in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the
26 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
27 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
28 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
29 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
30 Stat. 984).
