## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (P.L. 100-485 The Family Support Act of 1988)

WHEREAS,	Public Law 100-485, the Family Support Act of 1988, was
	enacted into law on October 13, 1988 to revise the AFDC
	Program to emphasize work, child support, and family
	benefits, to amend Title IV of the Social Security Act
	to encourage and assist needy children and parents under
	the new program to obtain the education, training and
	employment needed to avoid long term welfare
	dependence; and

- WHEREAS, the Family Support Act of 1988 creates a new AFDC education, training and employment program, known as Job Opportunities and Basic Skills Training Program (JOBS);
- WHEREAS, included in the Family Support Act is a provision which allows the Tohono O'odham Nation to request the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) for direct funding to conduct a JOBS program; and
- WHEREAS, the JTPA Program has submitted for review and approval, a Notice of Intent to apply for JOBS Program funds under the Family Support Act of 1988 in the amount of \$43,870.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the submission of the Notice of Intent to apply for JOBS Program funds under the Family Support Act of 1988.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted to further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 12th day of April , 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,512.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 128.0 (06) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
