

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY '90 Title XX Grant - Child Day Care)

RES. NO. 101-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has consistently supported the  
2 nurturance of its young members by providing for their  
3 welfare through various programs and services designed  
4 to meet their special needs; and

5 WHEREAS, the Child Day Care Services Program has been success-  
6 fully operated through the Early Childhood Division and  
7 has served many young Tohono O'odham Children; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is desirous of  
9 continuing this program for the benefit of its young  
10 members; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has previously applied for and  
12 received funding to operate the Child Day Care Service  
13 Program from the Department of Economic Security, Block  
14 Grant Administration, Title XX Day Care; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the  
16 proposed grant and finds the same to be of benefit to  
17 the Child Day Care Service Program.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
19 Council that it does hereby approve the proposed grant  
20 for Title XX Child Day Care Services.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
22 Council will not fund or operate programs from which  
23 grants are requested herewith which have not been  
24 negotiated and executed by the Department of Economic  
25 Security prior to the start of the funding year.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
27 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: The  
28 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are  
29 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,  
30 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the  
31 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be  
32 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
on the 18th day of April, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum  
was present with a vote of 1,523.5 for; -0- against; 116.5 not

voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
