

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY '89 Johnson O'Malley Budget Amendment)

RES. NO. 102-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Johnson O'Mally Program under FY 1989 P.L. 93-638
3 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

4 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels
5 of the contract shall be submitted for review and
6 approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and

7 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legisla-
9 tive hereby approves this amendment to the Contract and
10 authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached
11 budget.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
13 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: The
14 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
15 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Contract,
16 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
17 funding or funding levels of this Contract shall be
18 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
20 on the 18th day of April, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
21 was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
22 voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
23 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
24 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
25 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
26 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
27 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
28 984).
