

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Urging the Appointment of Dr. Edd Brown as Assistant  
Secretary of Indian Affairs)

RES. NO. 105-89

1 WHEREAS, information has been received by the Legislative Council  
2 that the Secretary of the Interior, Manuel Lujan, has  
3 forwarded the name of Dr. Edd Brown to the President of  
4 the United States, George Bush, to be considered for  
5 appointment as the Assistant Secretary of Indian  
6 Affairs; and

7 WHEREAS, President George Bush did announce his intent to  
8 nominate Dr. Edd Brown as the Assistant Secretary of  
9 Indian Affairs on April 13, 1989; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. Edd Brown has shown to be highly qualified with  
11 demonstrated experience managing a large governmental  
12 agency with an annual budget in excess of \$1 billion  
13 dollars and over 7,000 employees; and

14 WHEREAS, this experience will enable Dr. Edd Brown to undertake  
15 the massive reorganization and management of the Bureau  
16 of Indian Affairs needed to return effective adminis-  
17 tration and credibility to the agency; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Edd Brown has also demonstrated a continuing  
19 commitment to tribal governments while working with the  
20 State of Arizona and is knowledgeable of Indian affairs  
21 and issues critical to tribal governments; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Edd Brown has served under both Republican and  
23 Democratic governors in the State of Arizona and has  
24 exercised diplomatic tact and gained important political  
25 skill necessary to, and inherent in the management of  
26 the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
28 Council that it does hereby support Dr. Edd Brown for  
29 appointment to the position of Assistant Secretary of  
30 Indian Affairs, and, urges his confirmation by the  
31 Senate as the Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18th day of April, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (k) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
