

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(BIA/Tribal Budget Priorities FY 1991)

RES. NO. 109-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs has
2 submitted to the Tohono O'odham Council the projected
3 funding amounts for FY-1991; and

4 WHEREAS, the Agency Superintendent submitted the Agency program
5 priorities and set program funding and staffing levels
6 to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by using the
7 Decision Ranking Chart for FY-1990; and

8 WHEREAS, the Agency Superintendent informed the Tohono O'odham
9 Legislative Council that the only change made from the
10 FY-1990 Budget Priority is the transfer of \$25,000.00
11 from the Land Operations budget added to Administrative
12 Services budget; and

13 WHEREAS, the Decision Ranking Chart allows the Tohono O'odham
14 Nation to participate in the Federal Budget process and
15 to allocate resources in the most cost efficient manner
16 which will provide maximum services and benefits for its
17 members; and

18 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed the decision
19 units and is in concurrence that the following Decision
20 Ranking Chart is appropriate:




