

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'odham Social Service Department Modification #2)

RES. NO. 116-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Social Service Department is  
2 presently operating the Tohono O'odham Social Service  
3 Program under FY '89 P.L. 93-638 contract with the  
4 Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

5 WHEREAS, the amount of program monies available for General  
6 Assistance, Child Welfare Assistance, Adult Custodial  
7 Care, Miscellaneous Assistance, Work Incentive Pay and  
8 Administrative Cost are insufficient to meet projected  
9 costs through September, 1989; and

10 WHEREAS, the authorizing Resolution requires that any amendments  
11 affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract  
12 shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono  
13 O'odham Legislative Council; and

14 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Social Service Department has sub-  
15 mitted a revised budget for review and approval by the  
16 Legislative Council reflecting the change in the funding  
17 level for fiscal year 1989.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legisla-  
19 tive Council does approve the revised Social Service  
20 budget and authorizes expenditures in accordance with  
21 the attached budget.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
23 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
24 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are  
25 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,  
26 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the  
27 funding or funding levels of this contract shall be  
28 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
30 on the 24th day of April, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum  
31 was present with a vote of 1,512.0 for; -0- against; -0- not  
32 voting; and 128.0 (04) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in  
the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution  
of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy  
Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
Stat. 984).
