1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council reviewed the
2 Running Agenda established for the May General Session;

23 WHEREAS, Council was informed that the Swimming Pool budget was

25 Committee and should not be included on the Running

28 Legislative Council hereby amends its Running Agenda for
29 the May General Session to include the above listed
30 items with the exception of the Swimming Pool.


31 The foregoing Legislative Order was DEFEATED by the Tohono

which a quorum was present with a vote of 269.0 for; 888.0
against; 354.5 not voting; and 128.0 (5) absent, pursuant to
the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI
of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the
Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
