26 agenda for May General Session


27 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham

O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
Stat. 984).
