9 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed the applications
10 and has recommended that the applications be denied
11 because the applicants failed to establish the following
12 membership requirement(s): TOHONO O'ODHAM CONSTITUTION,
13 ARTICLE II, MEMBERSHIP - SECTION (1A) & (1B); and

14 WHEREAS, the applications has come on for hearing before this
15 Council; and

16 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee did serve written notice of its
17 recommendation to reject the applications and of this
18 hearing, as required by Section 2, Article VI of the
19 Enrollment Ordinance, upon the person(s) who filed the
20 application(s) and such person(s) were not present at
21 this hearing; and

22 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed all of the
23 evidence presented and from such evidence finds that the
24 applicant(s) has failed to establish the foregoing
25 membership requirements.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that
27 it does hereby determine that the above named
28 application(s) for enrollment as members of the Tohono
29 O'odham Nation are hereby rejected.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham
31 Nation shall issue a Certification of Final
32 Determination of rejection and that the Enrollment

Committee serve Notice of Rejection of the applications
in accordance with the provisions under section 1 and 2
Article IIII of the Enrollment Ordinance.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham
Council on the 1st day of May, 1989, at a meeting at which a
quorum was present with a vote of 717.5 for; 432.0 against;
321.5 not voting; and 169.0 (06) absent; pursuant to the powers
vested in the Council by Article II and Section 1 (h) of Article
VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by
the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
