

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Committees to Review Enrollment Ordinance)

RES. NO. 140-89

1 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has been reviewing membership
2 applications for enrollment into the Tohono O'Odham
3 Nation; and

4 WHEREAS, the Committee through its review process determines that
5 the applicants have failed to establish the membership
6 requirements under the Tohono O'Odham Constitution,
7 Article II Membership; and

8 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee would serve written notice of
9 its recommendation to reject the applicants for failure
10 to establish the foregoing membership requirements; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is concerned
12 about the rejections currently being addressed.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
14 Council that it does hereby cease addressing Enrollment
15 Rejection issues and refers to the appropriate
16 committees a thorough review of the Enrollment
17 Ordinance.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
19 Council will continue to address the names submitted for
20 membership approvals.


21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
22 on the 2nd day of May, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was
23 present with a vote of 931.5 for; 498.0 against; 52.5 not voting;
24 and 158.0 (05) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
25 Council by Section 1 (h) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
