

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(O'Odham In Mexico Budget Amendment)

RES. NO. 143-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham in Mexico in its quest for aboriginal
2 lands and Treaty Rights; and

3 WHEREAS, with the increased problems on said lands; and

4 WHEREAS, the statement of goals for the O'Odham In Mexico as
5 established is the use of legal consultant on documents
6 obtained from the different agencies of the Mexican
7 Government; and

8 WHEREAS, the long range goal of the O'Odham In Mexico is getting
9 political support and public awareness requires
10 additional funds in the amount of \$27,798.00 to attend
11 workshops with support groups, press and media
12 conferences; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham in Mexico does hereby request from
14 the Tohono O'Odham Nation additional funds to carry out
15 said goals.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
17 Council that it hereby approves the budget amendment in
18 the amount of \$27,798.00 .


19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
20 on the 3rd. day of May, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
21 was present with a vote of 947.5 for; -0- against; 365.5 not
22 voting; and 327.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
23 Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of
24 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
25 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
26 Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
27 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
