

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Schuk Toak Land Subjugation-Small Reclamation Loan)

RES. NO. 148-89

1 WHEREAS, under the provisions of Title III of P.L. 97-293
2 (Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act) and the
3 contract executed thereunder, the Nation has the
4 responsibility of subjugating land within the Garcia
5 Strip of the Schuk Toak District for the purpose of
6 utilizing water to be delivered under the Act; and

7 WHEREAS, the Nation, as authorized by a prior resolution, is in
8 the process of applying for a Small Reclamation Loan to
9 enable it to carry out its land subjugation
10 responsibility; and

11 WHEREAS, to obtain a loan under the provision of the Small
12 Reclamation Loan Act, it is necessary that the Nation
13 commit Nation funds for the purpose of meeting the
14 requirements for obtaining this loan which include non-
15 reimbursable contributions of Nation funds and
16 reimbursable working capital funds; and

17 WHEREAS, the Nation's Water Project Office has prepared a budget
18 and budget justification for the purpose of meeting the
19 requirements of the Small Reclamation Loan Act, a copy
20 of said budget and budget justification is attached
21 hereto and made a part hereof; and

22 WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 309 of Title III of P.L.
23 97-293, the contract executed thereunder and the
24 Ordinance creating the Trust Account thereunder
25 authorizes the use of these trust funds for the
26 subjugation of these lands, a copy of the Nation's
27 Counsel's legal opinion is attached hereto and made a
28 part hereof; and

29 WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Nation that the
30 attached budget and budget justification be approved and
31 that the necessary funds to implement this budget be
32 authorized to be taken from P.L. 97-293 Trust Income.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the budget and budget
2 justification, attached hereto and made a part hereof,
3 for the purpose of meeting the requirements for
4 obtaining a Small Reclamation Loan for subjugation of
5 lands with the Garcia Strip of Schuk Toak District is
6 hereby approved.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that use of P.L. 97-293 Trust Income is
8 hereby authorized to pay the costs and expenses of
9 implementing the Schuk Toak Land Subjugation Budget.


10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council

12 was present with a vote of 1,238.0 for; 280.5 against; 121.5 not
13 voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
14 Council by Section 1 (d) (2) (5) (f) (i) & (2) of Article VI of
15 the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
16 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the
17 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on
18 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
19 (48 Stat. 984).


