

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'Odham Education Recommendations)

RES. NO. 152-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council placed on its May  
2 1, 1989 legislative agenda for discussion the issue of  
3 the Swimming Pool budget; and

4 WHEREAS, the discussion brought out many issues that need to be  
5 discussed by the Human Resource Development Committee,  
6 Education Committee and Education Department Staff.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
8 Council that the Human Resource Development Committee,  
9 Education Committee and Education Department discuss the  
10 educational concerns and make recommendations to the  
11 Council in two (2) months.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the recommendations include the  
13 support of the Executive Branch.


14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council

16 present with a vote of 1,492.5 for; 84.5 against; 63.0 not  
17 voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
18 Council by Section 1 (c) (2) of Article VI of the Constitution  
19 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
20 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy  
21 Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
22 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
23 Stat. 984).






