

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Support of Demonstration Project Year Two Funding)

RES. NO. 161-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health Department (TOHD) has  
2 established a set of long range strategic goals for the  
3 organizational development of the Tohono O'Odham Health  
4 Department; and

5 WHEREAS, these strategic goals are consistent with the expressed  
6 intent of the Indian Self Determination and Education  
7 Assistance Act, P.L. 93-638; and

8 WHEREAS, P.L. 93-638 provides the Tohono O'Odham Nation direct  
9 authority and responsibility in determining and  
10 responding to the Tribally identified health care needs  
11 of the community as well as insuring the organizational  
12 growth and development of the Tohono O'Odham Health  
13 Department; and

14 WHEREAS, the Demonstration Project has fulfilled its mission to  
15 date as documented in reports prepared quarterly.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham  
17 Legislative Council supports the renewal of funding for  
18 Year Two of the Demonstration Project in the amount of  
19 \$275,000.00 for the period between July 1, 1989 - June  
20 30, 1990.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
22 that it hereby approves the Demonstration Project Year  
23 Two funding budget including the Indirect Cost.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Health Department  
25 will quarterly brief the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
26 Council on the status of this Demonstration Project  
27 throughout the funding period.


28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Health Department  
29 shall be responsible for project oversight and will  
30 provide direction throughout the demonstration period.

31 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
32 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: The  
Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are


hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant or contract, provided, however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this grant or contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th day of May, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 863.5 for; 563.5 against; 128.0 not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
