- WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation is aware that this potential shortfall is due to the use of Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement funds to provide facility repair at Sells Service Unit rather than to provide direct care services; and
- WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation has identified that \$205,088.00 of Medicare and Medicaid reimbursements funds for Fiscal Year 1988 and \$419,775.00 of Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement funds for FY '89 were used for facility repair; and
- WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation believes that these funds should have been used to fund direct care services.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation demands that the headquarters of the Indian Health Services realign resources within its FY '89 budget to replace the funds taken from Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement in the amount of \$624,863.00 to insure the Sells Service Unit provides the level of direct services such funds would have initially made available.
