

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Reallocation of Resources to Support Contract Health Services
Needs of the Tohono O'Odham Nation)

RES. NO. 165-89

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation has
2 been made aware of the projected deficits in contract
3 health services funding for the Tohono O'Odham Nation in
4 the amount of \$946,640.00 likely to occur in FY '89
5 based upon current rates of expenditures for contract
6 health services; and

7 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation is
8 aware that current efforts to reduce the rate of
9 contract health services expenses for FY '89 would still
10 result in a projected deficit of \$688,768.00; and

11 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
12 recognizes that such deficits and any further action to
13 reduce the deficit contributes acutely to a threat to
14 the health and safety of the O'Odham; and

15 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation is
16 committed to attain and maintain the highest level of
17 health care services to the O'Odham.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of
19 the Tohono O'Odham Nation calls upon the Headquarters of
20 the Indian Health Services to reallocate its resources
21 for FY '89 to ensure that contract health services
22 requirements are funded at a level which in no way
23 jeopardizes the health and services of the O'Odham or
24 precludes them from receiving any service which is not
25 defined as elective or purely discretionary.


26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the Indian Health Service fail
27 to appropriate funding for contract health services for
28 the Tohono O'Odham Nation the Congress will be apprised
29 of this situation and will be asked to intervene on
30 behalf of the Nation with Indian Health Services.


1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this action will be taken within
2 thirty (30) days of the signing of the Resolution in
3 order that the health and welfare of the O'Odham be
4 secured.

6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
7 on the 9th. day of May, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
8 was present with a vote of 1,402.0 for; -0- against; 238.0 not
9 voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
10 Council by Section 1 (c)(2), (f), & (j) of Article VI of the
11 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
12 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
13 Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
14 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
15 Stat. 984).
