

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Call for Special Election on Initiative/Referendum Measure)

RES. NO. 168-89

1 WHEREAS, the Election Board did on May 5, 1989, notify the  
2 Chairperson of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
3 that Initiative or Referendum Petition No. 01-03-89 had  
4 been signed by more than three hundred registered voters  
5 of the Nation, and did request the Council to call a  
6 special election to vote on the measure within ninety  
7 days of receipt of the notice in accordance with the  
8 provisions of section 7(D) (1) of article XII of the  
9 Uniform Election Ordinance; and

10 WHEREAS, the petition was filed too late for the measure to be  
11 submitted to the voters at the general election  
12 scheduled on May 27, 1989; and

13 WHEREAS, the ordinance requires that the measure be submitted to  
14 a special election of the voters within ninety days of  
15 receipt thereof; that the Election Board conduct the  
16 special election in accordance with the provisions of  
17 article XII of the ordinance and with the relevant  
18 provisions of the ordinance governing general elections;  
19 that the Election Board prepare and distribute a  
20 publicity pamphlet; and that the Council prepare an  
21 analysis of the ballot proposal for inclusion in the  
22 publicity pamphlet.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
24 Council that it does hereby call a special election on  
25 Saturday, July 29, 1989, to vote on Initiative or  
26 Referendum Petition No. 01-03-89, and does hereby direct  
27 that the Rules Committee - no later than May 29, 1989,  
28 and after providing reasonable opportunity for comments  
29 by all Council Representatives - file with the Election  
30 Board, on behalf of the Council, an analysis of the  
31 provisions of the measure, together with a list of

popular arguments favoring and opposing the measure, in accordance with the provisions of section 11(B) of article XII of the Uniform Election Ordinance.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of May, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 824.5 for; 274.0 against; 286.5 not voting; and 255.0 (7) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (g) of Article VI, Article XIV and Article XV of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
