

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Endorsement of John Gonzales as Assistant Secretary
to the Secretary of the Department of the Interior)

RES. NO. 16-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is the second largest Indian
2 Nation in the United States located in southern Arizona,
3 with an enrollment of 16,531 members and a land base of
4 approximately 2.7 million acres; and

5 WHEREAS, the newly elected U. S. President, George Bush, is in
6 the process of making important appointments to assist
7 him in running his administration; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. John Gonzales is being considered as a candidate for
9 the position as Assistant Secretary of the Interior; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Gonzales has served his people at the local,
11 regional and national level; and

12 WHEREAS, such experience along with his educational background
13 will make him an effective Assistant to the Secretary
14 of Interior.

15 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation
16 hereby endorses John Gonzales as the Assistant
17 Secretary of the Interior.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
20 on the 6th. day of January, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
21 was present with a vote of 1,497.0 for; -0- against; 143.0 not
22 voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
23 Council by Section 1 (j) & (k) of Article VI of the Constitution
of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 984).
