

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Support of Provision "B" of Proposed Ordinance)

LEGIS. ORDER 170-89

1 WHEREAS, on May 19, 1989 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
2 considered a proposed draft ordinance titled, "Defining
3 the Powers, Duties, and Authority of the Office of
4 Independent Counsel;" and

5 WHEREAS, it became necessary to poll the Council on the following
6 provision of the proposed ordinance:

7 "B. Payment for Costs for Office

8 All costs relating to the establishment and
9 operation of the Office of Independent Counsel
10 shall be paid from funds appropriated by the
11 Legislative Council to cover the Office of Tribal
12 Prosecutor during the FY '89 appropriations and
13 which are hereby reprogrammed and budgeted in
14 accordance with the Legislative Council require-
15 ments for appropriations of future funds."

16 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Section B "Payment of Costs
17 for Office" of the proposed ordinance titled, "Defining
18 the Powers, Duties, and Authority of the Office of
19 Independent Counsel" remain as written to provide for
20 the payments of cost for the office of Independent
21 Counsel.

22 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham
23 Council on the 19th. day of May, 1989 at a meeting at which a
24 quorum was present with a vote of 1,029.5 for; 373.0 against;
25 120.5 not voting; and 117.0 (08) absent, pursuant to the powers
26 vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the
27 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
28 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
29 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
30 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
31 Stat. 984).
