

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Proceed in Open Session)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 174-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacted the
2 following legislation in closed session:

- 3 a. Resolution No. 169-89, "Establishment of an Inde-
4 pendent Counsel Office;"
5 b. Ordinance No. 02-89, "Defining the Powers, Duties,
6 and Authority of the Office of Independent Counsel;"
7 c. Resolution No. 171-89, "Reinstatement of Robert
8 Goodnight;"
9 d. Resolution No. 172-89, "Authorizing Budget for
10 Special Counsel;" and

11 WHEREAS, the aforementioned legislation was vetoed by the
12 Nation's Chairman; and

13 WHEREAS, Council was prepared to proceed in Closed Session to
14 discuss any possible overrides of said legislation; and


15 WHEREAS, a motion was brought forth to proceed with the above-
16 vetoed enactments in Open Session.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
18 Council that it hereby proceeds in an Open Session to
19 discuss the vetoed legislation, specifically:


- 20 a. Resolution No. 169-89, "Establishment of an Inde-

28 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham
29 Council on the 5th day of June, 1989 at a meeting at which a
30 quorum was present with a vote of 775.5 for; 447.5 against; 417.0
31 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
32 Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursu-
ant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
