

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(May 27, 1989 General Election)

RES. NO. 180-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did on Saturday, May 27, 1989
2 conduct a general election for the offices of
3 Representatives and Alternates to the Tohono O'Odham
4 Legislative Council; and

5 WHEREAS, the Election Board did issue and post its Certificates
6 of Election Results in accordance with section 6(E) of
7 article VII of the Uniform Election Ordinance,
8 certifying to the election of the candidates who
9 received the highest number of votes for elective
10 office; and

11 WHEREAS, under section 6(N) of article VII of the Uniform
12 Election Ordinance, it is incumbent upon this Council to
13 issue Certificates of Election to the candidates who
14 received the highest number of votes for each Council
15 seat within twenty days after the Election Board has
16 posted its Certificates of Election Results provided,
17 however, that no election contest statement has been
18 filed against the candidates within the time allowed and
19 provided for, and provided further that they hold no
20 other elective office of the nation.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairperson and Secretary
22 of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council are hereby
23 authorized and directed on behalf of the Council to
24 execute and deliver a Certificate of Election to the
25 following persons elected from their respective
26 Districts as Representatives and Alternates to the
27 Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council, who shall hold their
28 offices for a term of four (4) years and until their
29 successors are certified and seated, namely:






