LEGIS. ORDER NO. 190-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council proceeded with  
2 the elections of the Cultural Preservation Committee in  
3 accordance with Section 3 of Article XIII of the  
4 Legislative Rules; and

5 WHEREAS, the following Council Members were candidates for the  
6 Legislative Cultural Preservation Committee and received  
7 the indicated amount of votes:

12 receiving the highest number of the votes cast, shall be  
13 deemed to have been elected to the Legislative  
14 Committee."

15 WHEREAS, a run off election was held between Cross Antone and  
16 Joseph Juan for the fifth seat on the Cultural  
17 Preservation Committee.

18 WHEREAS, Cross Antone received 1,157.5 of the votes cast and  
19 Joseph Juan received 566.5 of the votes cast.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
21 Council hereby certifies the election of,




29 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham

the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pur-  
suant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
