(Appointment by Acclamation of the Judiciary Committee)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 195-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council proceeded with  
2 the elections of the Judiciary Committee in accordance  
3 with Section 3 of Article XIII of the Legislative Rules:

13 WHEREAS, there were five candidates for the Judiciary Committee.


14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative

28 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
29 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pur-  
30 suant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
