

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Appointment by Acclamation to Legislative Committees)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 199-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council conducted
2 elections for Legislative Committees in accordance with
3 Section 3 of Article XIII of the Legislative Rules; and

4 WHEREAS, upon completion of the elections there remained
5 vacancies on the following Legislative Committees:
6 Housing Committee (2), Rules Committee (1), Water
7 Resources Committee (1); and

8 WHEREAS, Councilman Joseph T. Joaquin announced his candidacy for
9 the Housing Committee and Councilman Cross Antone was
10 nominated for aforementioned Committee; and

11 WHEREAS, Councilman Andrew Patricio announced his candidacy for
12 the Rules Committee; and

13 WHEREAS, Councilman Earl A. Francisco announced his candidacy for
14 the Water Resources Committee; and

15 WHEREAS, Councilmen Joseph T. Joaquin, Cross Antone, Andrew
16 Patricio, and Earl A. Francisco are eligible candidates
17 for said Committees.

18 WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 3.F.1, "Appointment by Accla-
19 mation," of the Legislative Rules states, " In the
20 event that the number of candidates are equal to or less
21 than the number of vacancies existing, the Legislative
22 Chairperson may request a motion and second from the
23 floor to appoint all the candidates to the vacant
24 positions."


25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
26 Council that it hereby appoints by acclamation: Joseph
27 T. Joaquin and Cross Antone to the Legislative Housing
28 Committee; Andrew Patricio to the Legislative Rules
29 Committee; and Earl A. Francisco to the Water Resources
30 Committee, in accordance with Article XII, Section
31 3.F.1. of the Legislative Rules.

quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0-


1 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
