

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(El Paso Gasline Right-of-Way Distribution
Hickiwan District)

RES. NO. 202-89

1 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council through Resolution
2 No. 18-89 did submit a request for El Paso Gasline
3 funds; and

4 WHEREAS, the amount of \$38,760.00 will come forth to the Hickiwan
5 District; and

6 WHEREAS, the \$38,760.00 will be divided equally among the seven
7 (7) communities of Hickiwan District at \$5,537.40 per
8 community; and


9 WHEREAS, the seven (7) communities of the Hickiwan District will
10 deposit their funds in the Ajo Valley National Bank; and

11 WHEREAS, it will be up to the communities of the Hickiwan
12 District as to how they want to utilize these funds.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
14 Legislative Council hereby approves the withdrawal of
15 \$38,760.00 to the Hickiwan District.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
17 on the 6th. day of June, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
18 was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
19 voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
20 Council by Section 1 ((d)(3)) of Article VI of the Constitution
21 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
22 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy
23 Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
24 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
25 Stat. 984).




