1 WHEREAS, the agenda established was reviewed for the June 8, 1989  
2 meeting; and

3 WHEREAS, a request was made to move item #1-"San Lucy Housing  
4 Rehabilitation Project, San Lucy District Land Use  
5 Planning Committee" and item #2-"Discussion on  
6 Resolution No. 147-89 (Delegation to Farming Authority

12 Swimming Pool.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham

32 Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).
