

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing the appropriation of P.L. 99-503 funds for  
implementation of the San Lucy Housing Rehabilitation Program)

RES. NO. 208-89

1 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District has adopted a Housing Strategy  
2 that will address the overall housing needs of the  
3 district, for decent and safe housing for the membership  
4 of the San Lucy District; and

5 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District has determined that it is in the  
6 best interest of the District and its membership to  
7 proceed immediately with the implementation of the  
8 rehabilitation of the original 24 housing units as well  
9 as to implement a district wide housing strategy; and

10 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District has determined that it is in the  
11 best interest of the District and its membership to  
12 implement and fund the Housing Rehabilitation Project  
13 and the District Housing Strategy, utilizing Public Law  
14 99-503 Settlement Funds; and

15 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council did authorize, by  
16 Resolution No. 04-32-89, the allocation of Public Law  
17 99-503 Settlement Funds in the amount of \$779,237.00 in  
18 order to fund the rehabilitation of the original 24  
19 units; and

20 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does recognize  
21 the housing needs of the San Lucy District; and

22 WHEREAS, Public Law 99-503 (enacted on October 20, 1986) does  
23 allow the use of settlement funds for provision of  
24 housing rehabilitation.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham  
26 Legislative Council has determined that it is  
27 appropriate, and in the best interest of the Tohono  
28 O'Odham Nation and San Lucy District to authorize the  
29 allocation of Public Law 99-503 funds in the amount of  
30 \$779,237.00 to fund the San Lucy District Housing  
31 Rehabilitation Project and Strategy.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislature does  
hereby authorize the San Lucy District to expend the

1 \$779,237.00 in accordance with the budget reviewed by  
2 the Legislative Council and in accordance with the  
3 policies and procedures set by the Nation's Accounting  
4 Office.



6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
7 on the 8th. day of June, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum  
8 was present with a vote of 1,491.0 for; -0- against; 233.0 not  
9 voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
10 Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
11 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
12 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
13 Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
14 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


